



# Hattie's 2018 updated list of factors related to student achievement: 252 influences and effect sizes (Cohen's d)



#### **Collective Teacher Efficacy**


- Group cohesion and confidence in our abilities as a collective team is associated with greater success of intentional efforts/goals (Bandura, 1977).
- When a team of educators come together, unify their efforts, and BELIEVE in their combined ability to overcome challenges and influence intended student outcomes, there are significantly higher levels of academic achievement (Bandura, 1993; Hattie, 2018).










