

Care Agreements and Custody Orders Quick Reference

Care: Physical care and control of the child	
Guardianship	Care Agreements
Parent remains the guardian	1. Voluntary Care Agreements
	2. Special Needs Agreement
	3. Extended Family Plan (EFP) <i>Formally known as Agreement with a Childs Kin or Others</i>
	4. Youth Agreement
Guardianship is neither formally nor fully removed from parent	5. Care of a child after a removal until an order is made

Custody: Includes care and guardianship of a child	
Custody	Custody Orders
Director is temporarily the guardian	1. Interim Order
	2. Interim custody to a person other than parent under the director's supervision
	3. Temporary Custody to a person other than the parent under the director's supervision
	4. Temporary Custody Order
Director is the child's guardian	5. Continuing Custody Order
Guardian is no longer the Director	6. Transfer custody of a child in the continuing care of the director to a person who is not the child's parent
