Visual Questionnaire Example Questions

Is the student able to:

- Make use of simulated mental imagery to solve problems?
- Analyze and synthesize visual information?
- Recognize patterns?
- Read maps, graphs or charts?
- Attend to fine visual detail?
- Recall visual information?
- Appreciate spatial characteristics of objects?
- Recognizes spatial orientation of objects?
- Organize information on a page?
- Print neatly?

Does the student:

- Have a good sense of direction?
- Lose their place easily when reading or copying?
- Lose things for class or assignments?
- Get confused about left and right?
- Catch and throw a ball accurately?
- Keep materials organized?
- Understand symbolic concepts in science and math?
- Have difficulties with making mental images?
- Have challenges with spatial planning?
- Have difficulty understanding non-verbal communication?
- Have challenges with non-routine information?
- Make mistakes, such as number reversals or transpositions, when completing calculations (e.g., number transposition or reversals)?
