Purpose:

This form is **not for individual student referrals for direct therapy**.

Description of Consultative Support:

SLPs at the middle and high school level provide support to educators within a school on a consultative basis. Services are for those staff who work with students with complex communication needs who require augmentative and/or alternative communication systems. This may include systems such as iPads with communication apps, paper-based communication boards and books, voice output switches/buttons, etc.

SLPs work closely with educators to help build team capacity for supporting their students with complex needs during everyday school activities and learning; however, direct therapy is not available within this consultative framework.
